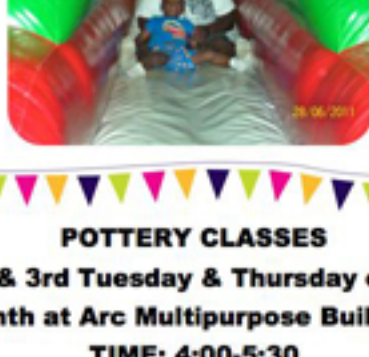




2011 SUMMER ADVENTURE

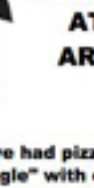

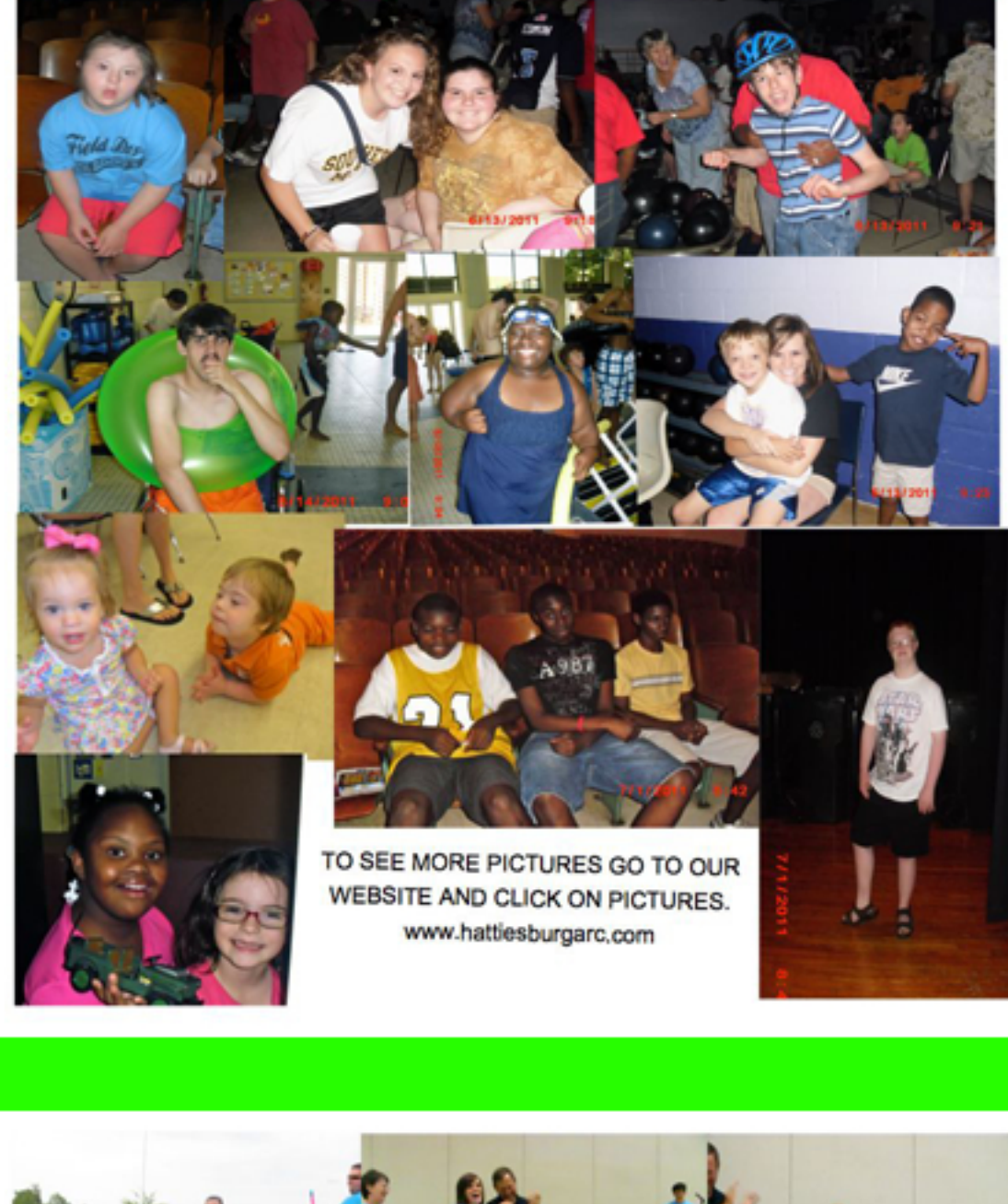
